Jail Visitation & Release Information

For jail visitation information call (928) 539-7841 between the hours of 9:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m.

Visitation Information

Visitation is by appointment only. Appointments must be made one day in advance.

- **Minimum Security Units:** Prisoners housed in the Minimum Security Units are eligible for two (2) one (1) hour visits per seven (7) day period.
- **Medium & High Security Units:** Prisoners housed in the Medium & High Security Units are eligible for one (1) one (1) hour visit per seven (7) day period.
- **Juveniles:** All Juveniles will be authorized visitation according to their level on the Juvenile Education Level Advancement Program.
- **Special or Out of Town Visits:** Any special or out of town visits must be approved by a Supervisor and conducted between the hours of **5:00-5:30 p.m.** unless otherwise stated by the approving Supervisor.

Visitor Requirements

All visitors must have valid government picture identification with date of birth. No one under the age of 18 may visit a prisoner unless:

- Accompanied by a parent or guardian and present the following documentation:
 - Birth Certificate: An original birth certificate for the minor
 - Notarized Letter: If the minor is accompanied by someone other than a parent, a notarized letter from the parent authorizing the minor to visit the jail with this adult is required ***in addition to the original birth certificate.***
- Visitation was previously approved by the Detention Center

An exception to this rule is a minor who is married to a prisoner and is able to provide:

- Marriage Certificate; AND
- A valid picture identification

Jail Visitation Hours

Units and visitation times are subject to change or cancellation at the discretion of the Sheriff or his designee.

Prisoners housed in the following units must request each visit in writing via a prisoner request form.

The approved visits will be conducted during the time periods indicated for each unit, seven (7) days a week.

- The prisoners housed in the above listed units are eligible for only one (1) thirty (30) minute visit per seven day period unless otherwise approved by a supervisor.
- The approving supervisor will indicate the time and date for the visit.
- These prisoners will utilize the semi-private (secured) booths for visitation.



Scheduled Release Times

All releases from the Detention Center will be done during the following time periods:

8:00 a.m. - 2:00 p.m.

6:00 p.m. - 9:00 p.m.

11:00 p.m. - 6:30 a.m.

You may wait for releases in the Gazebo on 1st Street.

The above release schedule does not apply to prisoners posting bond. All prisoners posting a bond will be released **approximately two (2) hours** after receipt of the bond. We will make every effort to release those prisoners posting bond within the 2 hour time frame, barring any unforeseen events or emergencies within the facility.
