Burglary Suspects Arrested

Location of Incident: 12800 block of South Frontage Road – Yuma, AZ

On October 23, 2017 at approximately 5:00 a.m., the Yuma County Sheriff's Office responded to the 12800 block of South Frontage Road in reference to a delayed burglary at a business. Upon arrival, Deputies met with the reporting party who stated that unknown suspects had entered the business and pried open two cash registers. Deputies also learned that the business had been burglarized earlier in the week; however, it had not been reported. Deputies were able to recover video surveillance of the suspects.

On October 24, 2017, the Yuma County Sheriff's Office Criminal Investigation Bureau served a search warrant in the 10300 block of South Typhoon Avenue. Investigators located evidence linking the suspects to numerous burglaries that occurred in the county as well as burglaries that had occurred in the city of Yuma which are currently under investigation by the Yuma Police Department. The YCSO and YPD are working closely in their investigation of these cases.

The YCSO located and arrested two suspects linked to the burglaries.

Suspect 1: Justice Donnelly, 18, of Yuma, was arrested and booked into the Yuma County Detention Center on 10 counts of burglary, 5 counts of theft of means of transportation and 1 count of possession of burglary tools.

Suspect 2: A 17 year old, male juvenile, of Yuma, was arrested and booked into the Yuma County Juvenile Justice Center on 10 counts of burglary, 5 counts of theft of means of transportation and 1 count of possession of burglary tools
