Narcotics Seizure

Location of Incident: 8400 block of S. Yavapai Lane – Yuma, AZ

On Wednesday, December 2, 2020, at approximately 10:53 AM, the Yuma County Sheriff's Office was dispatched to the 8400 block of South Yavapai Lane in reference to a possible Domestic Disturbance. Deputies arrived on scene and made contact with individuals involved in the disturbance. During the course of the investigation, it was discovered there was an undisclosed amount of narcotics inside of the residence.

The Yuma County Narcotics Task Force (YCNTF)—which is a multi-agency task force comprised of officers and agents from the Yuma County Sheriff's Office, the Yuma Police Department, the U.S. Border Patrol, and the Homeland Security Investigations—were contacted and assisted with a obtaining a search warrant for the residence. During the service of the warrant, multiple packages containing methamphetamine were discovered. The combined weight of the packages of methamphetamine was approximately 66.15 pounds with an estimated street value of \$600,102.60 dollars.

The suspect, **Alejandro Corona**, 27, of Yuma, Arizona, was arrested and booked by the Yuma County Narcotics Task Force for Transportation of Dangerous Drugs, Possession of Dangerous Drugs for Sale, Possession of Dangerous Drugs and Possession of Drug Paraphernalia.
